Lost & Grounded - 'Keller Pils' 6.5

Sometimes the simple things in life are the best. Lost and Grounded take Pilsner malt from Germany and combine with three traditional hop varieties – Magnum, Perle and Hallertauer Mittelfruh – to produce a clean, unfiltered, Hop Bitter Lager Beer.

Thornbridge - 'Tzara' / Cologne Style Lager 4.5

Tzara is a Köln style beer, in keeping with the Kölsch but brewed here in Bakewell. Thornbridge use German hops, malt and yeast to make this as close as possible to the originals as we love this style of beer. Overall Tzara is crisp and refreshing with a hint of citrus, it is great for drinking all year round but particularly enjoyable outside in the long summer days.

Thornbridge - Lukas / Helles Lager 3.5

Thornbridge's brewers are huge fans of German beer, appreciating the consistent quality of the different styles produced and are always keen to make these here in Bakewell. Their Helles lager, Lukas, is brewed with Bavarian ingredients and undergoes a long lagering period to make sure it's in perfect condition when packaged. It's light, crisp and has just a little malt sweetness which is characteristic of this traditional style.

Braybrooke - Wildflower Lager 3.5

This Braybrooke's second collaboration with Michelin star chef Brad Carter, inspired by the scent and colours of the meadows surrounding our brewery. A Pils malt base is the backbone of this beer in which Tettnanger hops have been used for their hay and floral character, enhancing the herbal notes of the foraged wildflowers. Meadowsweet, elderflower and woodruff have been sun-dried and infused into the beer, resulting in an intensely floral potpourri. It's like a lagery stroll through a blooming garden.

The Kernel - Baltic Porter 4.5

Kernel have taken the bones of their popular Export India Porter recipe to form the basis of this Baltic Porter. The most significant difference is that it's fermented with lager yeast and lagered for 9 weeks, this creates a cleaner, smoother creamier texture. The flavour profile has more dark chocolate with still some milk chocolate velvetiness. The Baltic porter isn't dry hopped and the roastiness has been toned down a little for drinkability.

Lost & Grounded - Running With Sceptres / India Pale Lager 4.5

Lager's answer to IPA! This India Pale Lager has a biscuity base of Pils and Vienna malt with a touch of light crystal malt, then dry-hopped - peachy and piney, this is modern lager at its best!
